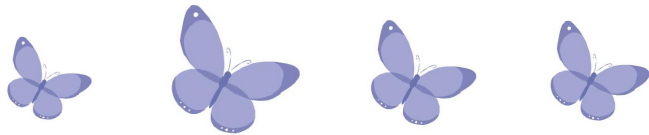
letting me show my old 1977 Lincoln Continental. Our local Cranker's Club will be sponsoring this show. They will be on our side and the care side.

Welcome Vicki!

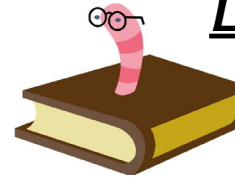
