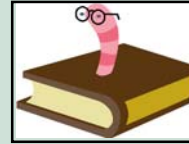

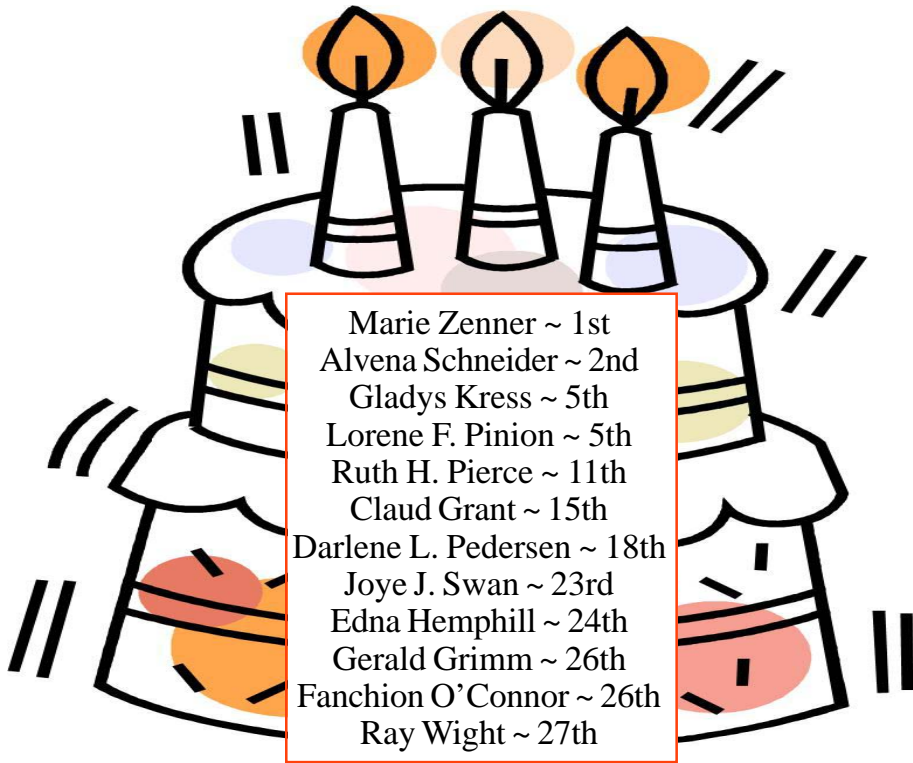


From the Kitchen
